Summer Landscaping Party Scheduled...We are scheduling a series of events throughout the calendar year to keep the grounds around Emmons School looking as nice as our students and families deserve. If you participated in either of our “weed-pulling parties” last fall, you know what a big job this can be. We are asking for your help on **Saturday, June 27th** to begin the first phase of our landscaping project.
